Whereas the draft of the following rules further to amend the Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Services. (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching Staff) (Recruitment) Rules, 2013 was published as required by clause sub-section (1) of section 3 read section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Service Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) in Notification No. HFW 169 IMM 2013, dated : 09-09-2015 of the Karnataka Gazette dated : 08-10-2015 in Para-IVA Page No. 1405-1407 of the Karnataka Gazette inviting objections/ suggestions from all person likely to be affected thereby within fifteen days from the date of its publication in the Official Gazette.

And whereas said Gazette was made available to the public on 08-10-2015.

And whereas no objection and suggestions have been received on behalf of the State Government.

Now therefore, in exercise of the powers conferred by sub-section (1) of section 3 read with section 8 of the Karnataka State Civil Service Act, 1978 (Karnataka Act 14 of 1990) the Government of Karnataka are by makes the following rules, namely :-

### Rules

1. Title and Commencement :- (1) These rules may be called, The Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Services (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching Staff) (Recruitment) (Amendment) Rules, 2015.
2. They shall come into force the date of their publication in the Official Gazette.
3. Amendment of schedule :- In the schedule to the Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Service, (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching Staff) (Recruitment) Rules, 2013 in the entries relating to the category of post of "Laboratory Technician (Drugs)", at Sl. No. 17 for entries in column 6 the following shall be substituted, namely :-  
"Fifty percent by direct recruitment and fifty percent by promotion from the feeder cadre of Laboratory Technician/store keeper/ Examiner (Advertisement)".

### Rules

1. **Title and Commencement:-** (1) These Rules may be called The Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Services (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching staff) (Recruitment) Rules, 2013.  
(2) They shall come into force from the date of their publication in the official gazette.
2. **Method of Recruitment and minimum Qualification:-** In supersession of Notification No: DPAR/59/SRD/2000, Bangalore, dated 22<sup>nd</sup> October 2002 the establishment of state service cadre in respect of The Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Services (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching staff) Recruitment Rules shall consist of such category of posts with scales of pay specified in column (2) of the schedule. The number and nature of posts, the method of recruitment and the minimum qualification, if any, shall be as specified in the corresponding entries in column (3), (4), (5) (6) and (7) thereof.
3. **Repeal and Saving:-** The Karnataka Health and Family Welfare Services (Drugs Control Department Non-teaching staff) (Recruitment) Rules, 2002 are hereby repealed.  
Provided that such repeal shall not affect -  
(a) the previous operation of the said rule or anything duly done or suffered thereunder; or  
(b) any right, privilege, obligation or liability already acquired, accrued or incurred under the said rules.

- (1) Notwithstanding anything contained in clause (h) of sub-rule-2 of the Karnataka Civil Services (General Recruitment) Rules, 1977, Equivalent qualification means a qualification specified by the Rajiv Gandhi University of Health Sciences, Karnataka, Bangalore, to be the equivalent qualification for the said post.
